Trophies will be given to first place in the beginner divisions, buckles in the junior and senior divisions. Additional prizes will be awarded to 5th place. (Depending on sponsorship, buckles may be given for first place in some of the beginner events) **Helmets & vests are required for all rough stock.** Vests & helmets will be available at rodeo. Boots, long sleeves & hats required for all events. Committee reserves the right to make changes in procedure and events as needed. **Rodeo will start at 9:30 CDT. Rules will be posted.** Roping partners and rescue race partners will be assigned if not filled in. Team ropers can only rope twice – no exceptions. Contestants must compete in their respective age groups cannot combine. **Everyone pays gate admission. Concessions will be available at rodeo.**
