

DACOTAH CENTENNIAL PARK – Facility Use & Parking Guidance for Horse/Rodeo Arena



- **PARKING** — Park in areas marked in **green**. **No overnight penning in areas marked “trailers only.”** **Avoid trailer parking and taking horses into areas marked in red; some are off property. Don't block gates.**
- **CAMPING SPOTS** — Map at <http://www.dacotahspeedway.net/fans/campground.aspx>.
 - No parking in utility spaces without reservation and payment. A double space is generally needed to tie or pen horses by trailer except for end spaces.
 - Other than July 1-4 and for high school rodeos, contact Speedway rep Casey, 701-202-8315.
 - One month before high school rodeos, see specific instructions and fees posted to the MHSC Facebook page, www.mandanhorseandsaddle.com and NDHSRA website.
 - Spots may be rented to non-contestants. Please avoid riding horses near campers.
- **PENNING OF HORSES** — Not inside chain link fence; gates are locked overnight. Moderate sizes pens allowed in designated areas by trailers (but not around trees). Clean-up required.
- **PENNING AROUND TREES & TYING HORSES TO TREES PROHIBITED** — Bark damage may expose trees to disease.
- **MANURE CLEAN-UP REQUIRED** — Look for wheel barrows and manure forks at 2-3 dumping stations setup during events for deposit of manure and hay from around your trailer or place in your trailer. No piles left behind!
- **STAY OFF NEWLY SEEDED GRASS.** Pedestrians and riders, please avoid crossing area where an old entrance road was removed. Seeded area has concrete barriers on both ends.
- **ARENA GATES** — Contestants enter arena on SW corner for roping events and north end for speed events. Exit from NE corner.
