Activities are held at Dacotah Centennial Park, 2428 Longspur Trail SE, Mandan, a facility owned by the Mandan Park District and annually leased by the MHSC.

Thanks to Dale Pahlke and many other generous sponsors, major upgrades were completed in 2023, including covered grandstands that seat 4,000 people, drain tile beneath a larger, crowned arena, new lighting, and a plug and play sound system. - Record sponsorship revenue!
- Equipment sales from prior arena: roping chute, timed-event stripping chute, and poles. Sound system payment received in 2024.
- Panel sales proceeds on deposit with the Mandan Rodeo Days Organization, to be used for mutually agreed upon capital and equipment improvements. The MHSC will receive reimbursement for \$11,700 in office building costs not covered by prior equipment sales, grants and donations.
- Facility expenses include \$50,000 grant passed through to Park District, office building at \$33,650, other miscellaneous items for new facility, and utilities (electrical, water, internet).
